

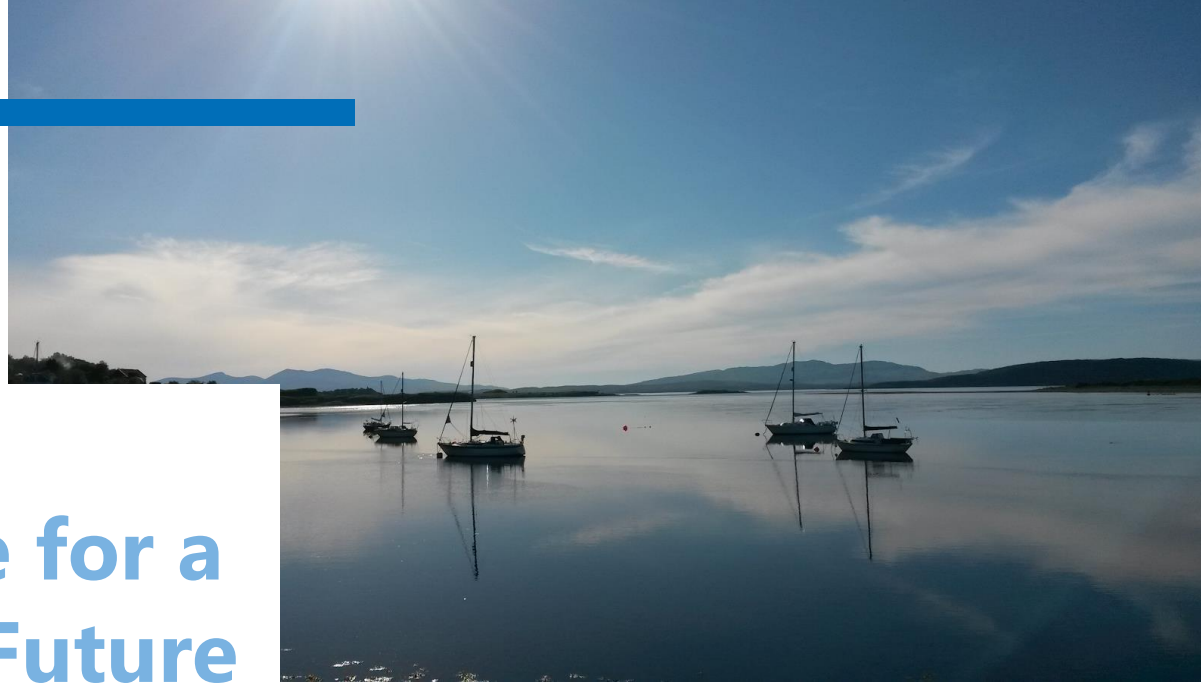
## *SAGES Stories:* Scottish Science for a Climate-Ready Future
