

Scottish Government Climate Change Plan, February 2018 Vision for Peatlands:

"By 2020, 50,000 hectares of degraded peatland will have been restored, and by 2030 we will have increased this to 250,000 hectares. By 2050, Scotland's expanded peatlands will be thriving habitats, sustaining a diverse ecosystem."
