Purpose of the accounts




GDP tells us only part of our economic story

- hides and excludes services provided by natural capital
- focuses only on flows, not stocks
- nature is priceless, not valueless

The natural capital accounts will:

- highlight links with economic activity and pressures
- monitoring losses and gains providing an integrated information









